Phillip Garrett Eastwick, Sr. (1838-1905)

Philip G. Eastwick who was Office Assistant, was a Civil Engineer of long experience who had been in the employ of the N. P. RR. Co. for several years, locating lines in the interior. In later years he entered the Govt. service and for years was stationed at Portland as Civilian Assistant, U. S. Engineer Department. He died in Panama about eight yearsⁱⁱ ago whither he had gone to visit his son, Major Eastwick, who was agent for the International Banking Co. at that point.
